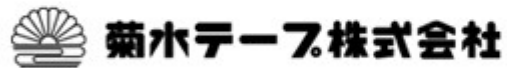

2025 Nitto and DIC changed membership as well. Nitto was one of original member when JATMA established in 1961.

By the company management policy

- The adhesive tape business is no longer a core part of the company.
- The domestic sales ratio is low, and motivation for Japanese industry's association activities is not increasing.
- The cost-effectiveness is too low

- Review of membership fees

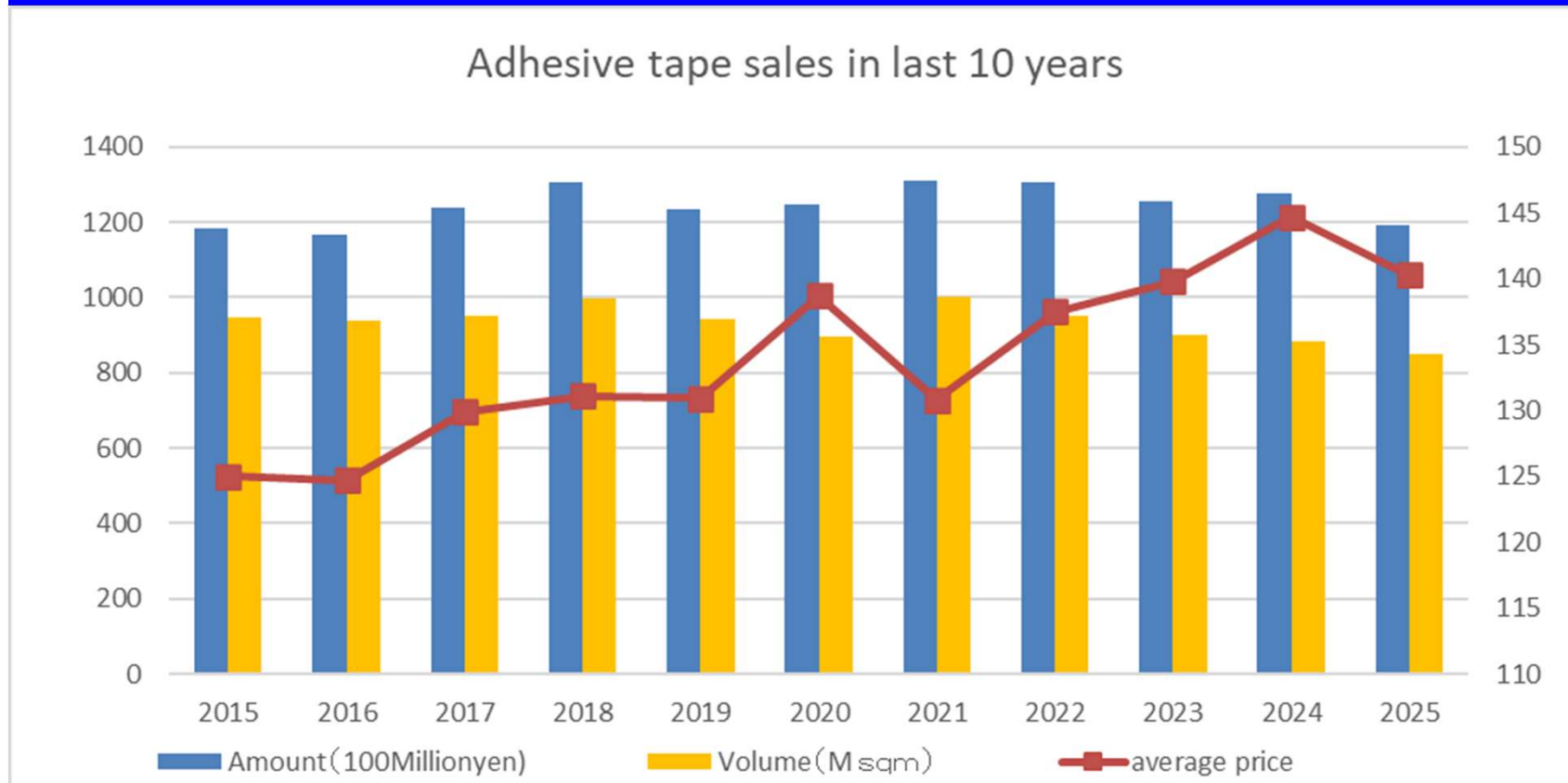
What can we do to expand the adhesive tape market?

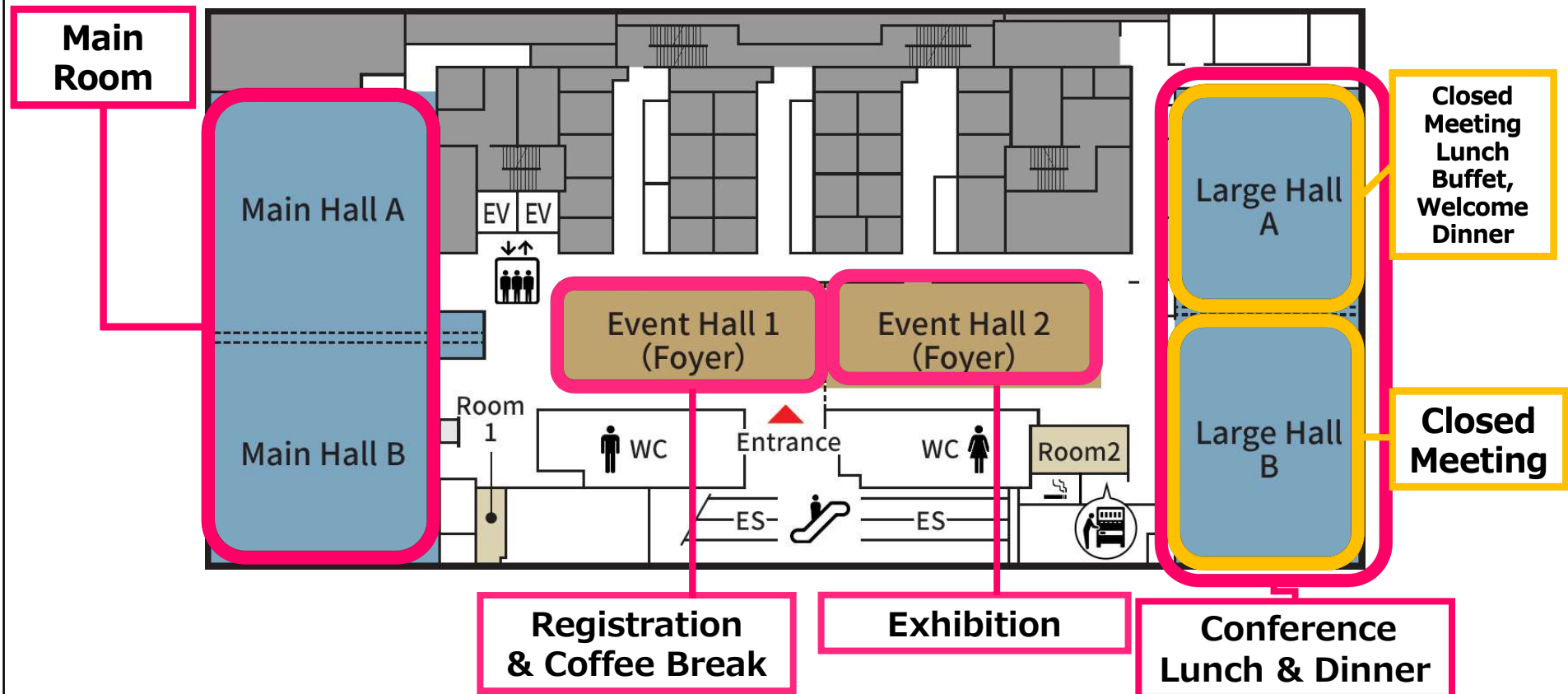
Seeking company exhibition
